The **S.A.V.E. Program** connects Danbury senior homeowners with volunteer service in Danbury City Departments and Nonprofit Agencies. The program began in July 2008 and is administered by The Volunteer Center of United Way of Western Connecticut for the City of Danbury.

**Senior program participants will receive up to a \$700 property tax credit for next year (2017-2018) after the completion of 100 hours of service by June 30, 2017.**

**S.A.V.E.** is open to qualifying Danbury residential homeowners ages 65 and above, with the following income guidelines:

**Single applicants must have an annual income from all sources of no more than \$57,900**

**Married applicants must have an annual income from all sources of no more than \$65,600**

**ONLY ONE PERSON per household is eligible.**

**All information regarding income will be kept strictly confidential.**

Placements are based on the skills and interests of the applicants. Tasks may include clerical duties – typing, filing, answering phones and similar administrative support or light maintenance work either indoors or outdoors.
