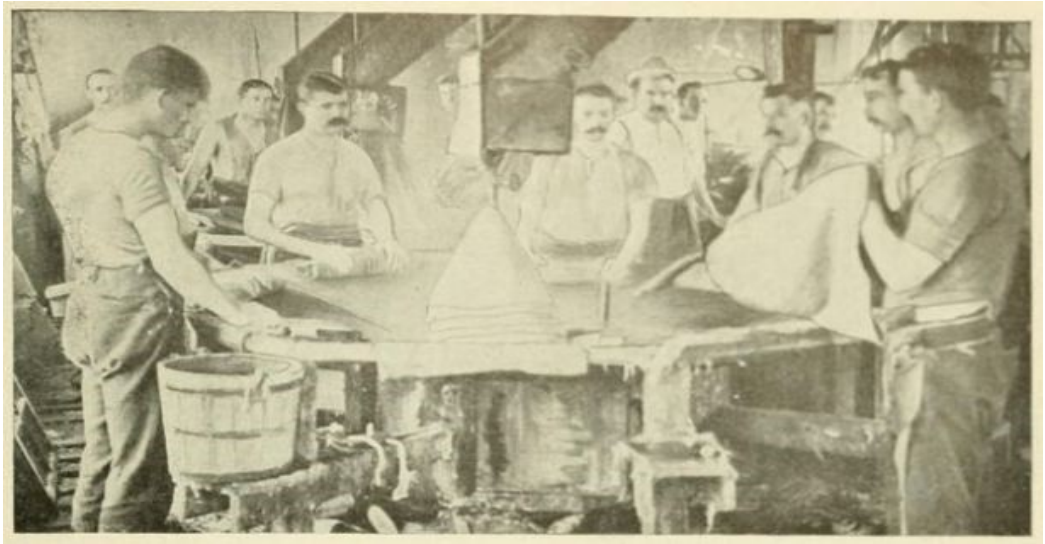

Join us for a lecture by John O’Donnell. He will discuss the United Hatters’ of North America strike against the Danbury hat-making factory of D.E. Loewe & Co.

The officers and 250 rank-and-file members of the Hatters’ Union who lived in Danbury and Norwalk embarked upon a strike which would last from 1901 until 1917. It would ultimately be decided upon by the U.S. Supreme Court.
